

M.Ed. in Middle Grades Concentration Areas: Math & Science

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How long does it take to complete the online Master's in Middle Grades Concentration Areas: Math & Science?

This 12-course, 36 semester hours program can be completed in four or more consecutive semesters (approximately 16 months) depending upon the number of courses a student is able to successfully complete each semester.

2. What are the admission requirements?

Must hold a valid Level 4 or higher Induction or Professional teaching certificate in Middle Grades Math and/or Middle Grades Science in the state of Georgia. Teachers certified in states other than Georgia may be eligible if they hold the equivalent of a Georgia professional teaching certificate in Middle Grades Math or Science. VSU reserves the right to request additional documentation, if needed. Applicants must be employed as a middle grades math or science teacher. Must have a cumulative undergraduate grade point average (GPA) or combined undergraduate and graduate GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.

3. Is the program designed as a cohort that determines a specific order for coursework?

No, students may enter the program and complete during any semester.
